1. E-book download preparation I: create an Adobe account

Why create an Adobe ID?

To download ebrary and EBSCO e-books you need an Adobe ID. The Adobe ID ties the e-books you download to your ID rather than the computer or device and enables the "checkout" of Langara library e-books.

Go to <u>https://www.adobe.com/</u> and click on Sign in On the next page, click on Create an Adobe Account

2. E-book download preparation II: download Adobe Digital Editions

If you will be downloading e-books to your computer rather than directly onto a mobile device, you will need Adobe Digital Editions, a free software program. The first time you run Digital Editions, you'll be prompted to authorize the application by entering an Adobe ID. You can use Adobe Digital Editions to read the e-books or transfer them to e-readers/mobile devices.

Son your own computer: download ADE here: <u>http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/</u> The Setup Assistant will guide you through a one-time activation procedure.

3. Find e-books on your topic in the library catalogue

Use the Library Quick Topic Search box. Enter search terms for your topic e.g. *nursing ethics, women history Canada, cooking, mystery fiction* On the Results page, limit to Format -- Online Book The e-book provider is: ebrary EBSCO Safari Other Find the catalogue link to the e-book. What do you notice about it? You can use the catalogue link to an e-book to reliably get it again.

4. Find ebrary e-books on your topic in the library catalogue & download them Do another catalogue search, adding 'ebrary' to your search terms e.g. journalism ebrary

Select a book to download, using the download button. ☑ Try downloading a chapter or page selection. It will download as a PDF.

> You can also try downloading an entire book on your mobile device.
