- **Original** (not a copy of someone else's work)
- **Does it solve a legitimate problem** (beyond the desire for the object)
- **Noncommercial** (it is not intended to be sold)
- **Innovative** (it creates some form of new knowledge, beyond simple technology use)

More appropriate Projects

- Objects made from upcycled materials or are mindful of material lifecycles
- Objects that showcase an innovative type of method or combination of processes
- A 3D print of your design that repairs something, extends its life, or makes it more useful

Not appropriate Projects

- Crapjects - uniquely useless, low value, “stuff” spawned by the rise of 3D printing and related technologies
- A downloaded object that you did not make, or can edit
- Cosplay costumes and pop culture paraphernalia
- No weapons of any kind
