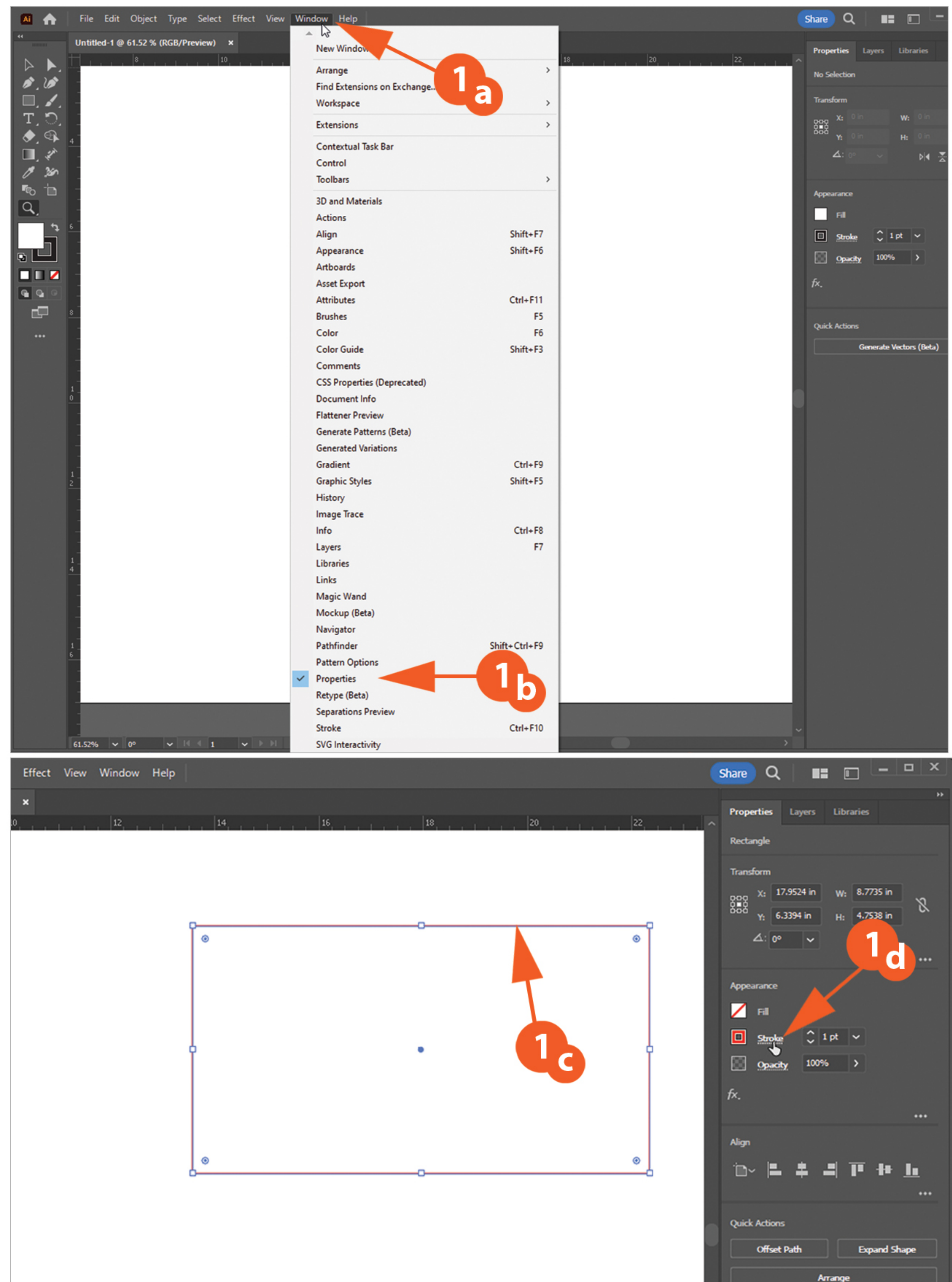

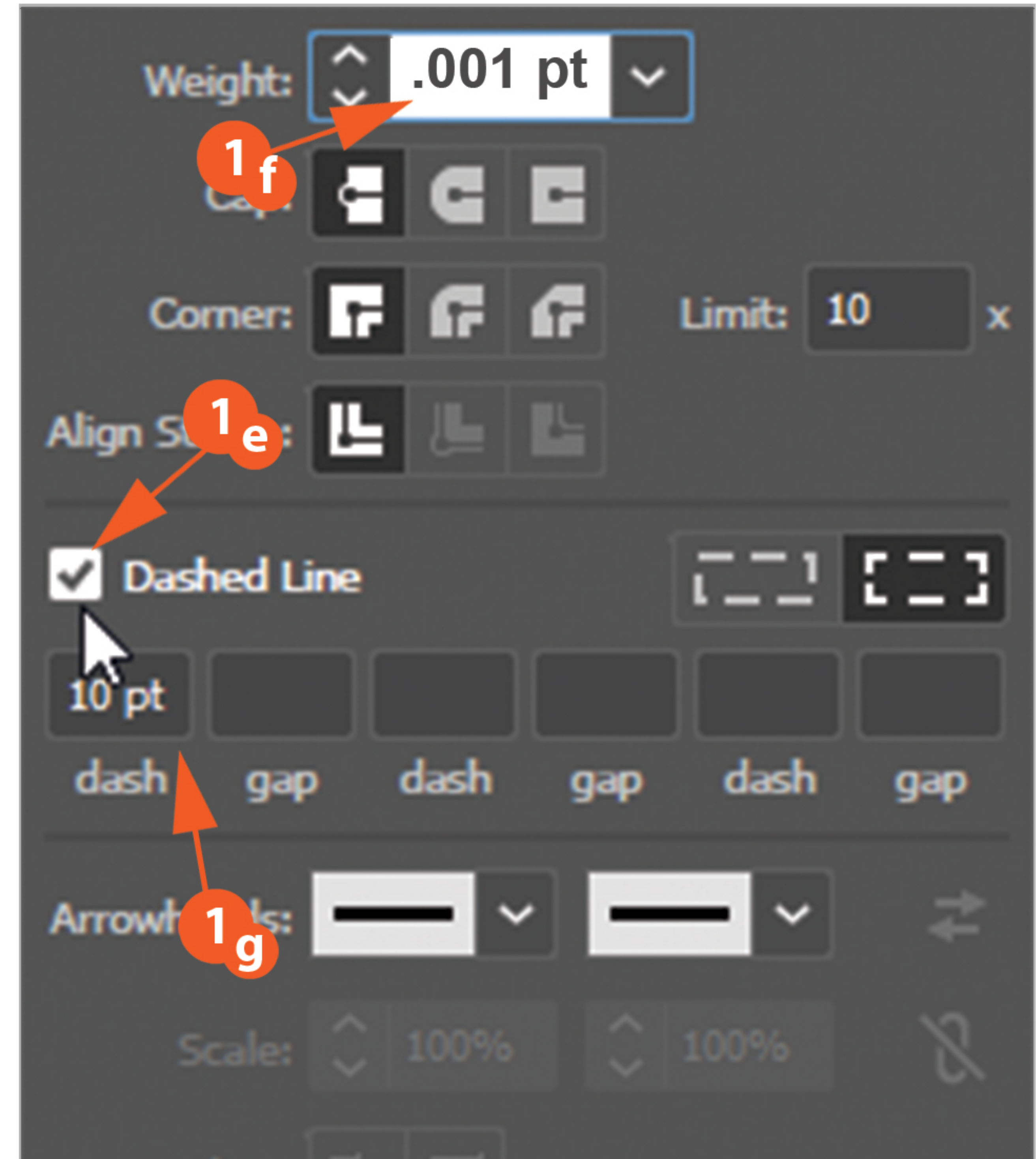
Creating a Dashed Line in Adobe Illiustrator

1a - Make sure the **Properties** window is open. If not, go to **Window**...

1b - and click on **Properties** to open it.

1c - Select the path you want to change to a dashed line.

1d - On the Properties Window, go to **Appearance/Stroke**. Left click on the word **Stroke**.

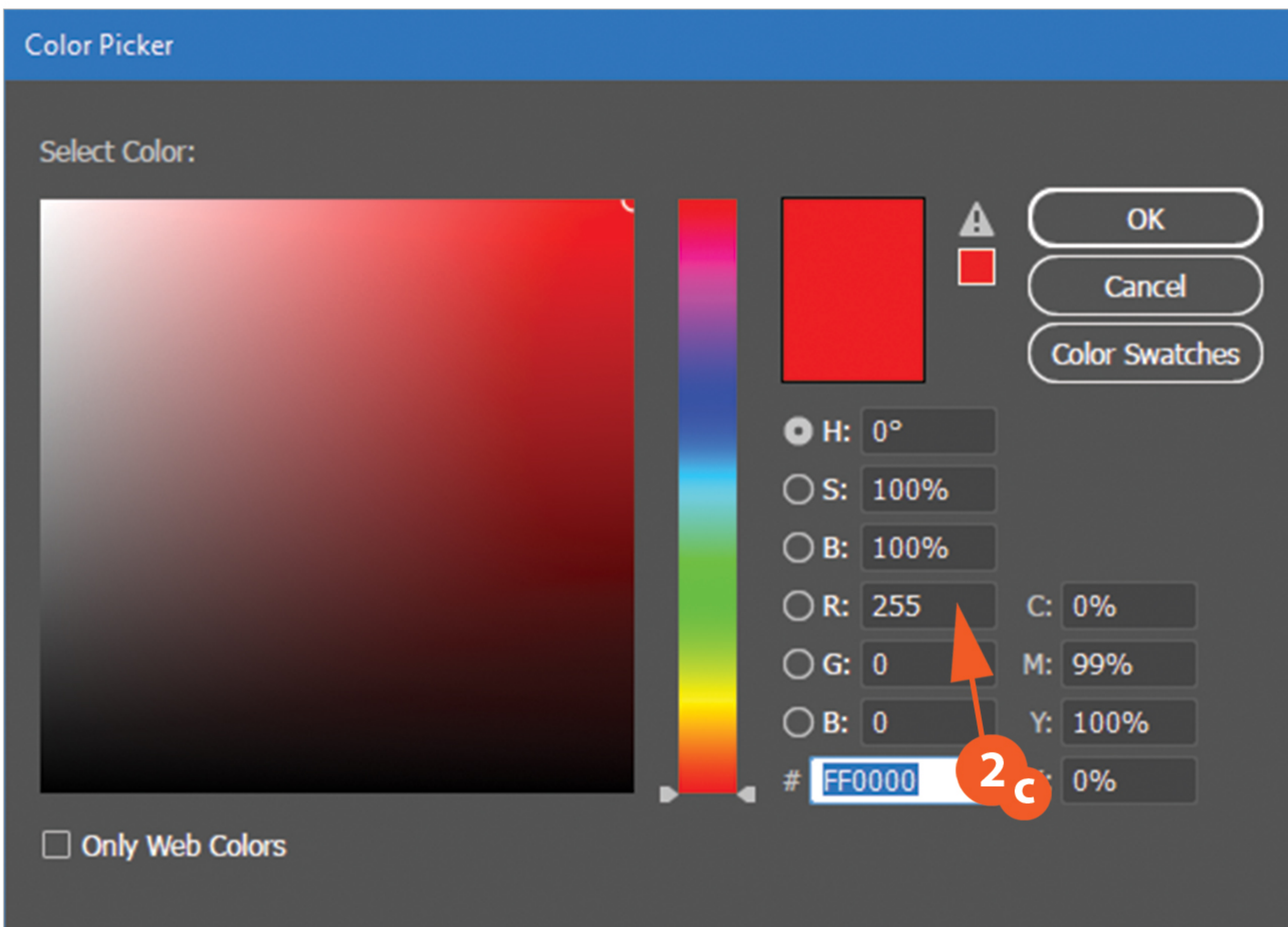
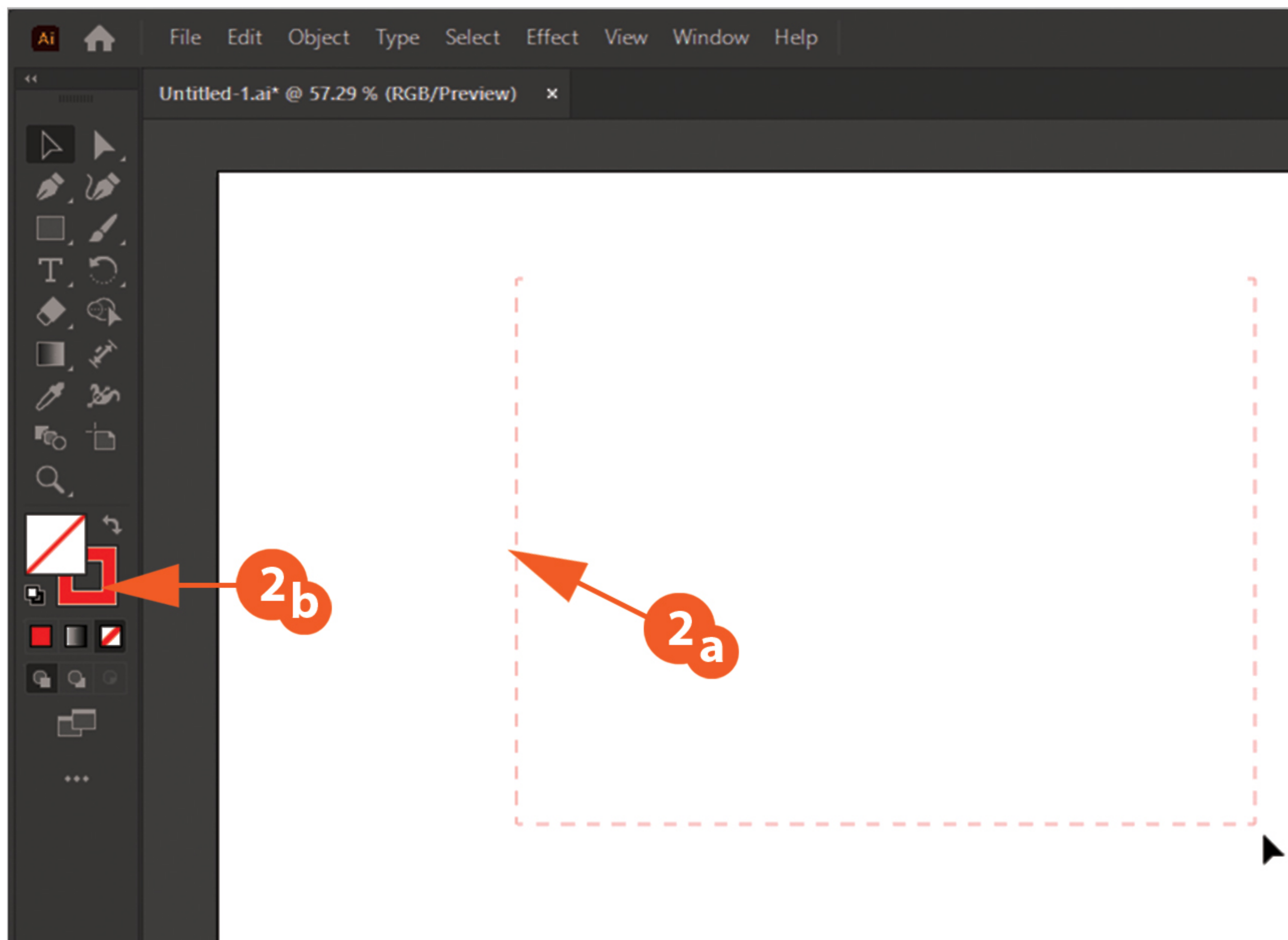


1e- On the pop-up menu, click on the **Dashed Line** check box.

1f - Under **Weight**, change it to **.001 pt**

1g - Set the **Dash** distance to **10 pt**

* **NOTE:** The next line you make will be dashed, you need to uncheck the dashed box to return to a solid line.

Make sure your Dashed line is pure red, as it is a cut line.

2a - Select your path.

2b - Double left click the **Stroke** colour square.

2c - On the pop-up, Change the colour to pure Red (255,0,0)

* **NOTE: The next line you make will be dashed, you need to uncheck the dashed box to return to a solid line.**
