

Time Needed for Your Courses (Part 2): Lab Courses & (More) Demanding Courses ...

Any Lecture Course that also has a Lab Section often takes more Time ...examples:

- Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Physical Geography & Any course that has a Lab section

Labs are often 2 hours week...So you need to Study at least 2-4 hours/week to pass the Lab:

So your **Total time for a Lab Course:**

- 12 hours for Lecture (See Part 1 Handout ...)
- The Lab part: 2 hours in Lab + 2-4 hours of Study = 4 to 6 hours week
- **Your Total Time:** $12 + [4 \text{ to } 6] =$
16 to 18 Hours for a Lab Course

Also ... Depending on Your Academic background & Prerequisites - You could need more time for Courses such as:

- English, Math, Statistics and Calculus, Computer Sciences, Language courses and any course(s) that needs you to do a Lot of Readings (textbooks, articles, etc.)
